



SUPPORTIVE MEASURES

ABOUT

- Non-disciplinary, non-punitive individualized support services offered as reasonably appropriate and without fee or charge to the Complainant or the Respondent
- Restores or preserves equal access to Education Programs or Activities without unreasonably burdening the other party
- OCRSM facilitates Supportive Measures in consultation with appropriate University officials
- Available upon the Title IX Officer or OCRSM receiving notification of alleged Prohibited Conduct and **does not require the filing of a Formal Complaint**

MAY INCLUDE:

- Academic Accommodations
- Housing Accommodations
- Employment Accommodations
- Care and Support
- Community Education
- Safety Services
- University Referrals

EXAMPLES:

- Extensions of academic deadlines
- Rearranging class schedules
- Facilitating changes in on-campus housing
- Arranging different work shifts or a temporary assignment
- Referral to counseling resources
- Assistance in arranging appointments with University resources
- Safety planning
- No Contact Order
- Denial of Access to campus
